First Sunday of Advent - Year B

Dear Parishioners,

A great advantage of gospel living is the constant opportunity for new beginnings. Advent, which begins today is the great symbol; of regeneration, a fresh start, the gift of starting over! Such a reality is beautifully summed up at the conclusion of today's First Reading from the Prophet Isaiah when he says:

And yet Lord, you are our Father
We the clay, you the potter
We are all the work of your hand

The wonderful image of God gently forming us from malleable clay, and even as we are formed with love and gentleness by the master potter, we find ourselves buffeted by the storms of life and small chips and imperfections appearing in our makeup. None of us last too long with the perfection with which God formed us, living tends to knock small pieces off us and we find the small imperfections appearing in our makeup and lifestyle. That is when we ask in prayer, for God the great potter to bend down and gently reform and reshape us on the wheel of life. We can see the hand of God caressing us with forgiveness and evening out with his touch the bumps and glitches that tend to accrue to us through life and its living.

Advent which comes to us today is a reminder of our need for new beginnings, a time to ask God to wash over us with his grace and, with the gentle and formative hands of the potter, to smooth out our rough edges and the inevitable bumps and ridges we all develop over time. In today's gospel Jesus reminds us to remain spiritually awake, to remind ourselves not to allow the divine potter to take his hands off us for too long lest we forget who we are and where we come from. Advent can bring us back on track, it can help us to once again climb onto the potter's wheel to be reshaped and remoulded as God wants. But the choice is ours, we have to want the new beginning, we have to be sufficiently aware that now is the acceptable time, now is the season of new beginnings. As we look forward to the coming of Christmas we remind ourselves it is not only the birth of as new baby but also the birth of a new phase in my journey to God.
