Dear Parishioners,

As we approach the last weeks of the Church's liturgical year, we are also aware that we are coming into that sacred time when we call to mind the Holy Souls are as we often say, the Faithful Departed. We are on the cusp of November, the month in which we traditionally remember and pray for those who have passed on to eternal life and who await our coming. It is as though we hold each other's hand as we guide and help each other on the journey.

It is a time to pray for those who have died, to show love and appreciation to those who helped us and to reconcile with those for whom we have less kindly feelings. As we think of those who were part of our journey, and in many ways still are, it is good to remind ourselves that we have all been blessed in an extraordinary way by the kindness and forgiveness of God. Now is an apt time to share the generosity of God with each other.
